Synonyms: Riesling x Sylvaner, Rivaner

Origin: Long thought to be a crossing of Riesling and Sylvaner, genetic sequencing has proved this variety to be a cross between Riesling and Chasselas de Courtilier.

Percentage of vineyards in Austria: 7 and sinking

Viticulture: This early ripening variety is predestined for cool climates. Sensitive to frost and prone to many diseases. Its advantages lay in high yields and minimum demand on location.

Style: White. The most popular style for this variety is dry, young, lively, and easy-drinking.

Character: Discreet Muscat aroma with flowery fruit.
