



RIESLING

Synonyms: Rheinriesling, Weisser Riesling

Origin: Germany

Percentage of vineyards in Austria: 3.5

Viticulture: This late ripening variety demands a sunny, south-facing, wind-protected slope. Although undemanding on soil-type, the very best examples always come from rocky soils like weathered primary rock or slate.

Style: White and nearly always dry in Austria.

Character: The best Austrian Rieslings nearly always come from the Wachau, Kremis, or Kamptal and have their own distinctive character: elegant, complex and multi-layered on the nose with clear apricot and peach aromas, simultaneously racy and delicate, with an aristocratic structure.
