**Synonyms: Pinot Blanc, Klevner, Clevner**

**Origin: Member of the Burgundy family where it also has its origins.**

**Percentage of vineyards in Austria: 6**

**Viticulture: Prefers deep fertile soils and a warm location. Hearty variety with good frost and disease resistance. Ripens beginning to mid-October.**

**Style: Very versatile. White, dry, full-bodied wines, sparkling wines, and also sweet botrytized wines are made from this classic grape.**

**Character: Compact, often nutty aroma. Full bodied, harmonious, and elegant.**
